MATERIAL FACT RENEWABLE ENERGY

Brisanet Participações S.A. (Company) (B3: BRIT3), the largest company among independent internet service providers in Brazil¹ and the largest fixed broadband provider in the Northeast region, according to Anatel's ranking, announces the use of renewable energy and shared distributed generation in its operations.

As part of the strategic growth plan and in line with important sustainability initiatives, the Company begins to negotiate energy consumption with companies in the electricity sector in the free market, providing more autonomy in its demands and greater energy efficiency. Thus, the energy required by the Company's units in Ceará and Rio Grande do Norte will come from **renewable and sustainable sources**, such as solar and wind generation. The initiative may provide monthly savings in energy costs in these states.

In addition, the Company also adhered to **Distributed Generation**, a segment in which energy is generated by consumers, close to or at the place of consumption. It is the opposite segment to the traditional Centralized Generation (GC), in which energy is generated in large plants and sent to consumers through transmission lines.

The state in which the Company chose to launch its Distributed Generation plan in the shared mode was Pernambuco. The novelty revolves around receiving renewable energy credits, especially from solar farms and biogas. In this way, membership will provide annual savings to the monthly energy consumption that the operation has throughout the state. It's predicted that by the end of the first half of 2024, consumer units in other states of Northeast (Ceará, Paraíba, Piauí, Alagoas, Sergipe, Maranhão and Bahia) will also be covered.

According to João Paulo Estevam, COO of the Company, more than saving on the cost of services, energy from renewable sources will offer benefits of great socio-environmental impact. *"Companies need to put ESG at the heart of their business. By adopting renewable energy, we made the decision to positively impact the entire ecosystem that surrounds our business. With 5G, we are going to increase energy consumption considerably. Therefore, by consuming renewable energy, we will contribute to the social, environmental and sustainable development of the region"* he says.

The telecommunications sector is highly dependent on the continuous supply of electricity to guarantee the functioning of its operations. In this context, Brisanet continues to work to prioritize the use of renewable energy, reduce consumption in general and optimize energy management and efficiency in its operations, thus reducing greenhouse gas emissions.
